


The Dubied machine offers quick, rapid

This yarn is soft and warm but also fluffy and light. It knits easily and adds quality to the finished garment.


It remains wearable and accessible, yet is more luxurious than common wool.





Fine Bamboo Tunic Delicate drops taken to Hand-knit cables Worked over shoulders






